To be eligible for the Overall Trifecta Champion & Reserve Champion the Horse/Pony/Rider combination must compete and gain a score in all offered Trifecta events at any one competition level at **all 3** listed AOR Trifecta Events.

For the purpose of deciding the overall trifecta champion at each level, points will be awarded to the horse/pony/rider combination at each leg of the Trifecta. The horse/pony/rider combination with the highest combined total after the third and final leg will be awarded the Champion. Second highest combined total will be awarded Reserve Champion. Refer to section 3.19 of the National Dressage Rules effective 1/1/2019 for the criteria for allocating points and deciding Champion & Reserve at each level.

Please advise of any known scratchings as soon as possible. All scratchings to toowoombadressage@gmail.com (please include your name, horses name and competition/s) up until Friday night. After Friday night please text to 0428 446 681 (Kerri).

All Competitors must complete and sign the attached Health Declaration Form & hand it in to Gear Check prior to riding. **No Declaration No Ride.**

When riding from the stables to the TEA Grounds please follow the arrows on the attached map. **DO NOT** ride through the Village Green which is a non horse camping area. You will risk elimination from the competition if you do.

Please note the gates to the showground do not open until 6.30am and will be closed at 8.30pm at night.

Please enter via the Main Gate. No other gates will be open.

Please pick up your manure and feed/hay from around your floats and place it in the designated waste area. Our Club is charged a cleaning fee if the parking/camping area is left unclean.

Draw – Please check the draw closely and advise the OC immediately at toowoombadressage@gmail.com if you believe there are any discrepancies in the draw in relation to competition and ride times.

Only horses/ponies entered to compete in the event are eligible to be on the grounds during the event.

Horse Identification (Bridle) Numbers MUST: be worn on both sides of the horse/pony any time it is out of the stable or when being ridden or led or hand grazed during the event.

Prize collection: The rider or a delegated representative **MUST** collect all prizes prior to the completion of the event on Sunday afternoon or the prize shall be forfeited. **NO** prizes will be held or posted.

ARENA FAMILIARISATION:

Outdoor Arenas: Around the outside of the arenas, Friday 3.30pm to 4.30pm, Saturday 7.30am to 8.00am, Sunday 7.30am to 8.00am.

Due care and diligence is taken at the time of publication; however no responsibility or liability is accepted for errors/omissions. The OC Reserves the right to change, cancel or amend the program/draw at their discretion.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

It is the riders' responsibility to know the rules under which they compete.

1. Rules -This event will be conducted under the current EA Dressage Rules, subject to any amendments or inclusions. **"Neither the Organising Committee of this competition to which these rules apply, or the EA, accepts any liability for accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever"**
2. Each horse/pony entered must have the same rider as nominated on the entry form for all competitions at the event. Any change of rider from the rider nominated on the entry form, must be notified to the OC before the commencement of the competition.
3. Horses/Ponies cannot be substituted.
4. Refunds: Only the entry fees will be refundable upon receipt of a doctor's (for the Rider) or veterinary certificate (at the discretion of the OC) and emailed within 24 hours of the event. These can be emailed to: Event Secretary at toowoombadressage@gmail.com. In such cases the organising committee reserves the right to retain up to 30% of the entry fees. The administration fee will not be refunded under any circumstances after close of entries.
5. Scratchings: Email Scratchings to toowoombadressage@gmail.com or after Friday night text to 0428 446 681. A rider may ride up into a scratching but may not ride down in the Draw to a scratching.
6. Horse Identification (Bridle) Numbers – This applies to horses/ponies entered into the AAOR competition. All Queensland dressage horses/ponies have been allocated a bridle number and this number **MUST** be worn on both sides of the horse/pony when out of the stable, being hand grazed or being ridden during the event.
7. Only horses/ponies entered to compete in the event are eligible to be on the grounds during the event. You will risk elimination if you are found to bring a horse/pony not entered in the competition.
8. Only Horses/Ponies saddled and being ridden or lunged are allowed in the designated warm up/lunging areas.
9. Horses/Ponies in halters and/or wearing rugs or being grazed are not permitted in the warm up area or competition area during the period of the competition each day.
10. **All stallion owners must abide by the EA Stallion Safe Practice Policy effective 1 July 2018. Please familiarise yourself with the requirements as set out on the EA website.** Stallion owners need to be aware of these guidelines and comply with the requirements and all other riders please be aware of stallions on the grounds.
11. All spectators/coaches/grooms **must** stay outside the warmup and competition areas.
12. Callers are permitted up to and including Advanced. Not permitted above Advanced.
13. Protests: Must follow procedures laid out in Section 1.5 of the 2019 Equestrian Australia National Dressage Rules and EA General Regulations articles 163, 164 and 165, EA Codes of Conduct, EA Member Protection Policy and its associated Attachment D1 – Complaints procedures, EA Disciplinary By-laws. Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$150.
14. All riders participating in the presentations are required to attend in their competition riding attire.
15. Swabbing may occur at this event.
16. Event Cancellation - If the event or competitions part thereof are to be cancelled the administration fee will be retained by the TD Inc.
17. **Dogs:** If dogs are present, they **MUST** be leashed and under control of the owner/handler at all times. The owner of any dog on the ground accepts the responsibility of the consequent action caused by the dog. All dogs should be restrained at all times. Dogs are not permitted in the arenas or practice/warm-up arenas. All riders, owners and officials are asked to keep dogs out of stabling and other horse areas and to ensure that their friends, family and clients also follow this directive.

WARMUP-/ LUNGING AREAS, GEAR CHECK (Please see the Attached Map)

- 1. Warm –Up Areas:** Warmup for the TEA Grounds is in the grass/sand area adjacent to the big sand arena. Final warmup is in the permanent sand dressage arena. FEI Horses may warmup in the permanent sand arena.
- 2. Lunging** – Lunging is only allowed in the Show Jump Ring or the area in front of the club house. Please refer to the attached map. Once you have finished lunging you may mount in the lunging area and ride to the warm up areas.
- 3. Gear Check** – will be at the entrance to the Arenas at the TEA Grounds. Riders must present for a visual gear check 10 minutes before their ride time, presented in CORRECT competition attire compliant with Section 5 of the 2019 Equestrian Australia National Dressage Rules. Riders must stand their horses' whilst undergoing gear check.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Event Office: The Event Office will be run from the TEA Clubhouse.

Championship Awards:

To be eligible for a Champion or Reserve Champion award at any level the Horse/Pony must compete in both competitions at that level.

Prize : Rosettes will be awarded to 8th place. Sashes will be awarded to each Champion and to each Reserve Champion. Prize money/goods/vouchers may be reduced at the OC's discretion subject to the number of entries per competition. Prizes for competitions will be cash and/or goods/vouchers to equivalent value. Prize money will be based on the number of horses/ponies that compete. Where 5 or more horses/ponies compete prize money to 3rd place, less than 5 horses/ponies prize money for 1st place only. Champions in the AAOR Competitions will be awarded a rug & Reserve Champions a saddlecloth. Champions in the Participant Competitions will be awarded a saddlecloth & Reserve Champions a sash.

Presentation of Prizes: Presentations will be held in at the TEA Clubhouse at the completion of each day's competitions. Competitors must collect their prizes. Prizes will not be sent. Riders participating in the presentations are required to attend in their competition riding attire.

Presentation Times: approx 3.00pm Saturday & approx 4.00pm Sunday

Stabling: Stables will be in the Horse Selling Complex and WILL be allocated. See attached map. Do not use any other stable than the one allocated to you. A copy of the stable plan allocation will be available at the end of the Stable Complex. Stables MUST be left in a clean state prior to departure and all manure and hay must be removed and placed in the areas designated not left in laneways. The owner of any stable left unclean at the end of the event will NOT receive their stable bond back.

Camping: Onsite powered camping is available throughout the grounds. Camping will NOT be allocated but available on a first in first served basis.

Catering: Will be available at the event venue on Saturday and Sunday.

WELFARE OF THE HORSE – CODE OF CONDUCT

The Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) and Equestrian Federation of Australia (EA) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's/EA's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI/EA urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise. A full copy of the Code can be obtained from the FEI, Avenue Mon-Repos 24, CH-1000, Lausanne 5, Switzerland. The code is available in English and French. The code is also available on the FEI's website: www.horsesport.org.
