- **ELIGIBILITY OF HORSE/RIDER TO COMPETE IN PREP TESTS:** Entry for Prep tests is restricted to those combinations that have not won 3 or more Prep classes and/or placed in the top 3 of 3 or more Prelim classes at any previous Toowoomba Dressage Inc member's competition. or official event.
- **Riders may only ride a maximum of 2 horses per day. Please note that the event will be held with two adjoining arenas in the Indoor Area.**

**Stabling: \$27 per horse per day or part thereof. If staying overnight then pay \$27 per night (eg. arriving Saturday, leaving Sunday = \$27 per horse). Stable Bond \$50 – (refunded following event if stable is left clean)**

**Camping : \$25 per night**

## GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – ALL COMPETITIONS

### It is the riders' responsibility to know the rules under which they compete

1. Event will be run in accordance with current Equestrian Australia rules and current FEI rules (as amended). **“Neither the Organising Committee of this competition to which these rules apply, or the EA, accepts any liability for accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.**
2. Riders must be a current financial member of Toowoomba Dressage Inc for 2019. **ABSOLUTELY NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. NO EMAIL OR PHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**
3. One rider only per horse. OC must be notified of any change of rider before the event starts. In the event of illness or accident to rider prior to the commencement of the event, a substitute rider if a member of Toowoomba Dressage Inc may be arranged, however a substitute horse cannot be placed instead of the nominated horse.
4. Eligibility of horses: **Horses may only compete in two consecutive levels at the event. Riders may only ride a maximum of 2 horses per day.**
5. A full copy of the draw will be emailed to riders.
6. No refunds after close of entries unless substantiated with medical and/or veterinary certification within 7 days of the completion of the event. No refund of the Administration Fee will be given.
7. Administration fee **MUST** be paid by all riders otherwise entry will not be accepted.
8. Objections: attention is drawn to the current Australian Dressage Rules and official procedure for dressage competitions. Only the owner/rider of a horse taking part in the competition may lodge a protest. This must be in writing to the Secretary of the event with a \$150 deposit not later than 30 minutes after the happening that gave rise to the protest or in the case of the qualification of the competitor, not later than 30 minutes before the start of the class.
9. The committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any section of the programme or to limit the number of entries if nominations are excessive or undersubscribed. The committee reserves the right to accept or reject entries. In the event that any competition receives more than 35 entries, the OC reserves the right to ballot entries to a reserve list created on a first in basis.
10. Ribbons etc **MUST** be collected at the competition or forfeited. Toowoomba Dressage Inc will not be responsible for mailing test sheets unless a self addressed, pre-paid business size envelope or \$2 for same is provided. Prizes/Rosettes will not be sent.
11. **Dogs** on the grounds are not a preferred option. If dogs are present, they **MUST** be leashed and under control of the owner/handler at all times. The owner of any dog on the ground accepts the responsibility of the consequent action caused by the dog. All dogs should be restrained at all times. Dogs are not permitted in the TEA Arenas and practice/warm-up arenas. All riders, owners and officials are asked to keep dogs out of stabling and other horse areas and to ensure that their friends, family and clients also follow this directive.
12. **All stallion owners must abide by the EA Stallion Safe Practice Policy effective 1 July 2018.** Please familiarise yourself with the requirements as set out on the EA website.
13. **As a condition of entry Toowoomba Dressage Members** who are entered in the event must be prepared to assist with the running of the competitions, or provide a volunteer worker, where required, ie pencilling, gear check, setting up arenas, test running etc. Members who do not provide a volunteer may have your entries refused for future competitions

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Stabling** must be booked and paid for with entries. Stable fees are per night or per day or part thereof. eg: If you are arriving on Saturday and leaving on Sunday you pay for one night of stabling (\$27). If you are only staying for the day or part thereof you pay for one day stabling (\$27). Stables will be allocated, a stable plan of allocation will be displayed at the end of the allocated stable block. Bedding is supplied on the grounds and in the stables, additional bedding can be added or purchased from the fodder merchant. **ALL stables MUST be cleaned out prior to departure. All manure and hay must be removed.** Owner of any stable left uncleaned will be charge a \$50 cleaning fee per stable.

**A stable bond of \$50 is required to be paid with entries.**

**Camping.** Onsite powered camping is available throughout the grounds. Camping must be booked and paid for with entries and will not be allocated but available on a first in first served basis.
